The manager has the right to override all listed requirements.

__1. ALL MAIDEN, BARREN & MARES NOT BRED IN 2011. A negative aerobic (regular) uterine culture at least 48 hours prior to breeding, but within 30 days of breeding, is required before the initial cover in 2011 and each cover thereafter. Any mare producing a dead foal from a 2011 breeding will be treated as a barren mare. **ALL MAIDEN MARES MUST BE JUMPED BEFORE COMING TO THE SHED.** () MAIDEN () BARREN () NOT BRED

__2. DOMESTIC FOALING MARES. No tests are required for the first cover.
FOAL HEAT: No__ ; YES__ (A breeding soundness Veterinarian Certificate must accompany the mare if marked yes.)

__3. IMPORTED MAIDEN MARES. All fillies of foreign origin must comply with the current USDA and Kentucky Department of Agriculture regulations.

__4. IMPORTED FOALING AND BARREN MARES. Contact the State Veterinarian's office in Frankfort, KY regarding testing procedures and acquisition releases for the 2011 breeding season. **A COPY OF THE QUARANTINE RELEASE MUST ACCOMPANY THE MARE ON HER FIRST TRIP TO THE SHED.**

__5. RETURN COVER. A negative (regular) uterine culture at least 48 hours prior to breeding is required for all mares if returning for a second heat and **ALL COVERS THEREAFTER.**

__6. DOUBLE. Any mare returning for a second cover in the same heat period **MUST** be palpated **THE DAY** the mare wants a double.
